

Suggestions for Improving Traffic and Pedestrian Safety in Stevenson  
**CURRENTLY UNDER CONSIDERATION**

These two first items are shown for information only - No current action required.

1. Limit out-of-state truck traffic.  
*Continue to attempt to work with our State Legislators to address this issue.*
2. Increase speed limit enforcement.  
*Continue to work with the Skamania County Sheriff's Office for increased speed limit enforcement in the downtown area. City Council now monitors the number of City calls responded to and traffic tickets issued by the Sherriff's Office each month.*
3. Further investigate radar ticketing. Contact other cities to see if the program pays for itself.
4. Paint "25 mph" signs on the pavement on 1<sup>st</sup> Street. (WSDOT will not allow on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street).  
*Added to Public Works TODO list, target completion date May 1, 2016 or earlier.*
5. Reconsider the one-way couplet next year.  
*Reconsideration scheduled for March, 2016 as per Council's request.*
