

**CITY OF STEVENSON, WASHINGTON
ORDINANCE NO. 2016-1100**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF STEVENSON,
WASHINGTON, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016, and CLOSING FUNDS 302 (BRIDGING BYWAYS),
305 (QUAD GATES), AND 307 (CASCADE AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS)**

Whereas, the City of Stevenson 2015 and 2016 budgets included appropriations for funds 302 (Bridging Byways Community Trail), 305 (Quiet Zone / Quad Gates), and fund 307 (Cascade Avenue Improvements), and

Whereas, these three projects have been successfully completed,

Whereas, the Clerk / Treasurer for the City of Stevenson recommends closing these funds and transferring the remaining balances in each fund to / from Fund 300 (Capital Projects), and

Whereas, a notice was published that the Stevenson City Council would meet on the 17th day of November, 2016, at 6:30 P.M. at the Stevenson City Hall to consider proposed amendments to the 2016 budget and giving taxpayers within the limits of the City of Stevenson an opportunity to be heard upon the proposed amendments;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Stevenson do hereby ordain as follows:

- 1. **Appropriations:** Expenditure Appropriations for Funds 300, 302, and 305 are hereby amended as shown below:

<u>Fund 302 (Bridging Byways)</u>	<u>Original</u>	<u>Amended</u>

<u>Fund 305 (Quiet Zone)</u>	<u>Original</u>	<u>Amended</u>
Transfer Out to Capital Improvements	\$ 0.00	\$ 9,868

- 2. **Fund Closures:** Funds 302 (Bridging Byways Community Trail), 305 (Quiet Zone / Quad Gates), and 307 (Cascade Avenue Improvements) are hereby closed and discontinued within the City of Stevenson 2016 Budget.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT and be in force five (5) days after its publication according to law.
