 - Resulted in our first organized deployment to a DNR fire as a single resource. We were able to staff a Type 6 Engine (Brush Rig) for 3 days
- Underwood Fruit Fire
 - Second deployment of Skamania County Fire Task Force to our mutual aid partners in the Columbia Gorge
