**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STEVENSON,
WASHINGTON, CONCURRING WITH REGION IV HOMELAND SECURITY
COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2017-01.**

Recitals

WHEREAS, since 2008, the counties Clark, Cowlitz, Skamania and Wahkiakum, as well as the cities, towns and other municipal corporations localized within these counties (“Parties) entered into an Omnibus Agreement (“Agreement”) to provide emergency assistance to each other during times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, since the execution of the Agreement, Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 38.56.10 was revised so as to effectively cover the provisions established in the agreement; and

WHEREAS, on November 29, 2017, the Region IV Homeland Security Council agreed to terminate the Agreement effective January 1, 2018 through Resolution 2017-01 (Exhibit “A”) pending concurrence of 2/3 parties as required by Article XVII of the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Stevenson that the Region IV Homeland Security Mutual Aid (Omnibus) Agreement be terminated in concurrence with Region IV Homeland Security Council Resolution 2017-01.

IN THE MATTER OF: Requesting termination of the Region IV Homeland Security Mutual Aid (Omnibus) Agreement between the various participating parties.

WHEREAS, since 2008, the Counties Clark, Cowlitz, Skamania and Wahkiakum, as well as the cities, towns and other municipal corporations localized within these counties (hereinafter called "Parties") entered into an Omnibus Agreement (hereinafter called "Agreement") to provide emergency assistance to each other during times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, since the execution of the Agreement, Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 38.56.10 was revised so as to effectively cover the provisions established in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on November 29, 2017, the Region IV Homeland Security Council agreed that the Agreement be terminated effective January 1, 2018, based on mutual aid provisions established in RCW 38.56.10

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REGION IV HOMELAND SECURITY COUNCIL in regular session on 29th day of November, 2017 that the agreement is terminated effective January 1, 2018 pending concurrence of 2/3 of the parties as required by Article XVII of the agreement.
