Board of Adjustment: The position requires attendance at periodic night meetings as needed but typically not more than once per year. Members are not paid. The duties of Board of Adjustment members include reviewing appeals of administrative decisions, reviewing requests for variances from the City's land development codes, and other duties as may be assigned by the City Council. Ideal applicants will be U.S. citizens, have respect for the quasi judicial process, and have a keen interest in the future of the community.

Planning Commission Member: The position requires attendance at one regular night meeting per month, attendance at occasional special meetings, U. S. citizenship, City residency, and a keen interest in the vitality, physical planning and future of the community. The duties of planning commission members include review of development projects, recommending guidelines and regulations for community development, and providing guidance to the City Council on planning issues.
